IN THE NEWS:

ALASKA MAN PLEADS GUILTY TO CONCEALING ENVIRONMENTAL CRIME, JUNE 21, 2002

Gary Hitchings, an officer and director of Technic Services Inc., an Alaska asbestos abatement contracting company, pleaded guilty on May 31 to misprison (illegal concealment) of a felony by failing to report a violation of the Clean Water Act. The violation involved the removal of asbestos from the Alaska Pulp Corp. in Sitka, Alaska.

Hitchings was responsible for assuring that all asbestos containing material at

the facility was properly removed in accordance with environmental rules and regulations. During the removal, the defendant learned that slushy waste containing asbestos abatement waste was allowed to enter a drain system at the facility and flow directly into Silver Bay in violation of the Clean Water Act. However, Hitchings concealed the violation. Discharging contaminated slurry into surface waters can be harmful to fish and other aquatic life.

-Set up a display with the award winners receiving their awards at your permit counters (pictures will be available after the event).

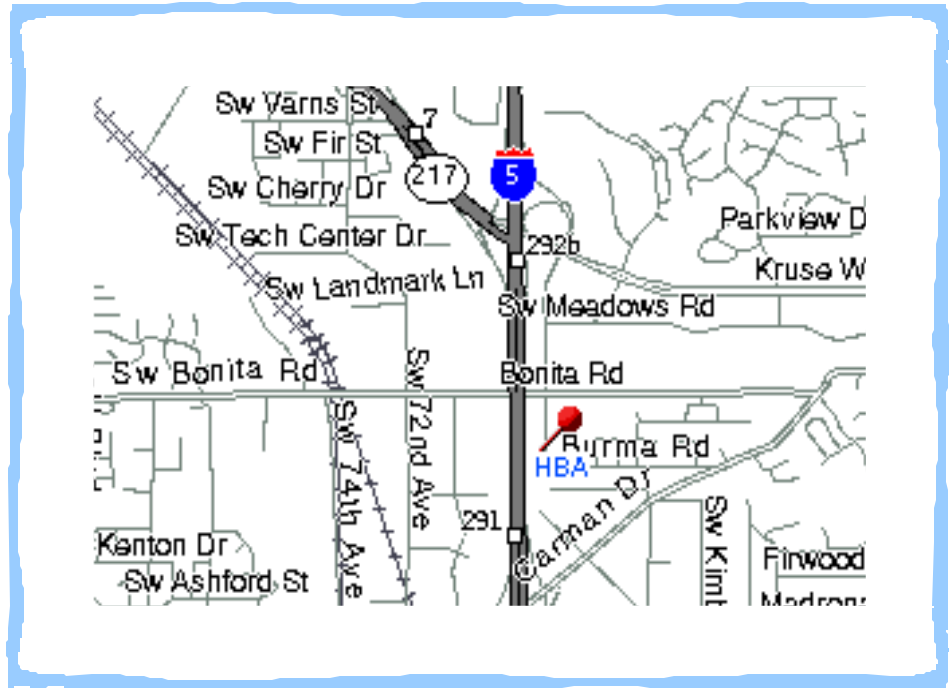
